Students will be sensitized with the importance of animals in our life. They will have a blizzard of playful activities which will give them hands on experience to deliver a message about welfare of animals. Class 2: "MAKE ME YOUR FRIEND" : The students Class-2 will design a stick puppet of any animal that they commonly find around share different ways they can follow to take care of them. Class 3: 'CARE FOR US....DONT BE CRUEL" The students of Class-3 will make a head-gear of an animals assigned to their section and write a sentence on the headgear about what they can do for welfare of that animal. Class 4: 'I CARE FOR ANIMALS' : The students of Class-4 will create a simple bird feeder/ dog feeding bowl to show their love for the birds and animals. Class 5: 'SAVE ANIMALS' The students of Class-5 will design a poster with slogan conveying the message of saving endangered animals. The students will also exhibit their puppets, bird feeders, headgears and posters.
